Aztec Twist

This is something I came up with on the way to work; it's similar to the star twists I've been working on, but it's done with a triangle instead of a higher-order polygon.

It's actually quite simple; all it consists of is a basic triangle overlap tiling with an added squash twist on top. getting it folded is a little tricker, and I think there might be a simpler way to do it... but this is what I have right now.

More than anything, this is just an example for you to look at. Expect a full version of this tessellation once I finish folding a final model and sort out all the folding requirements.


